Superintendent's Reports

A. Start of School Updates

- Student enrollment as of today is 700. The district retained approximately 90% of faculty and staff. There were 29 student transfers out and 40 new student enrollments..

B. Facilities Update

- Summer projects were completed prior to the start of school, including updated carpet, additions to the Tiger Legacy Wall, and new privacy/security window coverings at the Middle School entry.

C. Safety Update

- Mr. Berry Young (Serving Watchmen) provided a full-day safety training for all faculty and staff, focusing on key safety strategies. He also visited each building to answer classroom-specific questions. Staff provided positive feedback on the training, and a refresher course will be scheduled for the 2026–2027 school year.
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New Business

A. No-Tax Bond Increase Update

- Dr. Steggall shared that the district is on schedule with the No-Tax Bond Increase timeline. Staff feedback has been collected on facilities, and round-table discussions with stakeholders will be scheduled for further input. Veregy has provided preliminary drawings based on feedback; however, these are still early drafts. The board discussed possible additional and or alternative options, and Dr. Steggall will share that feedback with Veregy.
