## V. Student Recognition

- A. Mrs. Welch recognized the Adventures Kids 7th/8th grade gifted class for placing in the Top 20 in the Battle of the Brains competition, which included more than 6,700 students from 250 schools across 48 districts. Entries were reviewed by STEM professionals from Burns & McDonnell and Science City. The 7th/8th grade gifted students, along with the 5th and 6th grade gifted students, presented their project to the Board.

## VI. Superintendent's Report

- A. Finance Update – Dr. Steggall reported the fund balance remains in good standing and the district is awaiting tax revenue from the County Treasurer.
  - a. Local Tax Revenue Update – The district, along with neighboring schools, is awaiting a large county tax distribution. Dr. Steggall and the Lathrop superintendent will be meeting with the county regarding the delay later this week. The district was notified a check is ready for pickup tomorrow; the amount has not yet been disclosed.
