IV. Public Comment

Mayor David Jett addressed the Board regarding the upcoming 250th anniversary. Dr. Steggall will follow up with him regarding the event.

V. Program Spotlight - CAPS/Tigers on Main

Sydnee Yates and Madison Risch presented to the Board regarding the Tigers on Main student-led store. They provided an overview of the program structure, including students' participation in both academic coursework and operation of the store, and reviewed student responsibilities related to business operations.

Kati Lager presented on the CAPS program, including its structure and opportunities for students through internships and real-world experiences. She also provided an update on program growth and collaboration with surrounding districts.

VI. Superintendent's Report

Board of Education Appreciation Month

Dr. Steggall presented the Board with a certificate of appreciation in recognition of Board of Education Appreciation Month and thanked members for their time and dedication in serving the District.

Finance Update

Dr. Steggall presented the February financial report, including total revenue of \$490,594.89 and total expenses of \$1,666,744.22. Fund 1 ended the month with a balance of \$4,657,919.01, and Fund 4 with a balance of \$539,361.89.

Legislative Update

Dr. Steggall provided an update on several pieces of pending legislation that may impact the District. She discussed proposed legislation related to the elimination of Missouri's income tax, noting potential impacts to state revenue and an estimated loss to the District of approximately \$756,000 annually.

She also reviewed a proposed A–F school grading system that would assign letter grades to districts based on APR and test scores and discussed considerations related to its implementation.

Dr. Steggall further reviewed proposed changes to the state funding formula, including adjustments to the minimum levy and rollback cap, and discussed potential impacts to state funding and local revenue.

Dr. Steggall recommended approval for Cassandra Davis as District Treasurer and Tarah Turner as Board Secretary.
